Subject:- SWP No. 1993/2017 titled Javaid Ahmad Mapnoo Vs State and ors.

- 1) Whereas, the JK Services Selection Board vide advertisement Notification No. 07 of 2010 invited applications from eligible candidates for the post of Accounts Assistant (Finance Department), district cadres Bandipora under item No. 398 and 715; and
- 2) Whereas, the petitioner namely Javaid Ahmad Mapnoo belonging to ST category also applied for the said post and participated in the selection process conducted by the Board; and
- 3) Whereas, petitioner was shortlisted and called for interview but due to his own reasons has not appeared before the interview committee, as such could not be interviewed by the committee on the scheduled date; and
- 4) Whereas, the petitioner through the medium of SWP No 1993/2017 has approached Hon'ble High Court seeking directions against respondents to allow the petitioner to participate in the selection process against post of Accounts Assistant for district cadre Bandipora and accordingly conduct the interview for the said post; and
- 5) Whereas, SWP No. 1993/2017 has finally been disposed of vide judgement dated 03/10/2017. The operative part of the judgement dated 03/10/2017 is reproduced as under:

" Keeping in mind the peculiar geographical location as also the difficulty expressed by the petitioner as above, the respondent Authority is directed to accord consideration to the request of the petitioner for the interview that he missed. The authority is at liberty to consider the request as per applicable rules. The authority will accord consideration if the rules prescribed by the Services Selection Board provide for such an eventuality. It is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the claim

Writ petition alongwith connected Mp(s) disposed of as above".

- 6) Whereas, the JKSSB rules/regulations governing the subject do not permit holding of re-interview on the grounds taken by the petitioner.
- 7) As such, in compliance to the judgement of Hon'ble High Court dated 03/10/2017 passed in SWP No 1993/2017, the case of the petitioner has been duly considered and found devoid of any merit and hence rejected.
