Order No. 136 SSB of 2018

Subject: - SWP No. 819/2017 titled Razni Bala V/S State.

1. Whereas, the Services Selection Board advertised 06 posts of Vocational Instructor Preparatory School Management Divisional Cadre Jammu vide notification No. 01 of 2011 dated 31.01.2011 under Item No. 129 in the following breakup; and

2. Whereas, the petitioner applied for the said post under SC category and participated in the selection process but could not find her place in the final selection list issued by the Board; and
3. Whereas, after not being selected, the petitioner approached the Hon'ble High Court through the medium of writ petition bearing SWP No. 819/2017 and sought directions from the Hon'ble High Court to command the respondent to select and recommend the next meritorious candidate for the unfilled post of Vocational Instructor Preparatory School Management Divisional Cadre Jammu, under OM category.; and
4. Whereas, the Hon'ble High Court disposed of SWP No. 819/2017 vide judgment dated 06.04.2017. The operative part of the judgment dated 06.04.2017 is reproduced as under:

*"...In view of the aforesaid submissions and in the facts of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with the direction that in case petitioner submits the representation within a period of one week from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order to respondent no. 2-Secretary SSRB, the aforesaid authority shall decide the representation submitted by the petitioner by a speaking order within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order passed today".*


5. Whereas, in pursuance to court judgment, the representation of the petitioner was examined and it transpires from the records that the merit of the selected candidate namely Vinod Kumar under SC category is lower than the merit of the last selected candidate namely Rajni Devi under OM category and the merit of the petitioner is also

lower than the candidate namely Amrit Paul Singh for whom the post was kept unfilled at S. No. 4. The merit secured by the petitioner and other candidates is given as under:

Merit of the selected candidate under SC category namely <b>Vinod Kumar</b>	Merit of the petitioner under SC category namely <b>Razani Bala</b>	Merit of last selected candidate under OM category namely <b>Rajni Devi</b>	Merit of the candidate namely <b>Amrit Paul Singh</b> at S. No. 4 under OM category against whom the post was kept unfilled for want of certain clarification.
<b>49.7778</b>	<b>40.2222</b>	<b>50.8333</b>	<b>60.5000</b>

6. Whereas, after examining the whole case it is found that the slot at S. No. 4 under OM category which is kept unfilled for want of certain clarification pertains to the candidate namely Amrit Paul Singh who secured 60.5000 but department needs some clarification in this regard from the candidate and the process is underway; and
7. Whereas, it clearly indicates that the petitioner's claim against unfilled post under OM category is not justified as candidate Sh. Amrit Paul Singh has far higher in merit than the petitioner.

Now therefore, in compliance to judgment of Hon'ble High Court dated 06.04.2017 passed in SWP No. 819/2017 read with facts stated herein above, the claim of the petitioner has been examined and considered and found devoid of any merit, hence rejected.
