Subject:- SWP No. 280/2018 & MP No. 01/2018 titled Sham Lal V/s. State of J&K & others.

Whereas, the J&K Services Selection Board vide Advertisement Notification No. 01 of 2016 dated 01.06.2016 invited applications from eligible candidates for participating in selection process against Item No. 069 for the post of Dental Assistant/Junior Dental Technician,(Health and Medical Education Department) District Cadre Kathua; and

Whereas, the petitioner participated in the selection process for the post of Dental Assistant/Junior Dental Technician, District Cadre Kathua and was selected in the Provisional Selection List of candidate in the RBA Category; and

Whereas, the candidate alongwith others was called for Document Verification on 26th December,2017 at 10.30 A.M in the offices of J&K Services Selection Board vide notice no.SSB/Sel/Secy/2017/13323-26 dated 16.12.2017 and whereas, the candidates were intimated through the medium of aforesaid notice that those who will fail to appear before the Document Verification Committee shall be declared as disqualified; and


Whereas, the petitioner choose to remain absent on the scheduled date on 26.12.2017 for document verification in the offices of J&K Services Selection Board; and

Whereas, feeling aggrieved petitioner approached the Hon'ble High Court of Jammu and Kashmir at Jammu by way of SWP No. 280/2018 titled Sham Lal V/s State of J&K and others, which was disposed of by the Hon'ble Court vide its Judgment/Order dated 26.03.2018. The operative part of the Judgment/Order is reproduced below:-

*"...Writ petition is, accordingly, disposed of, at its threshold, with a direction to the respondents to treat the instant writ petition as representation and consider the claim of the petitioner, as projected in it, strictly in accordance with the rules, by passing a speaking order within a period of six weeks from the date of certified copy of this order along with complete set of writ petition is made available to them..."*

Whereas, in compliance with the order dated 26.03.2018 passed by the Hon'ble High Court in SWP No. 280/2018, MP No. 01/2018 titled Sham Lal V/s State of J&K & Others, the case of the petitioner was considered by the Services Selection Board in its 157<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 30<sup>th</sup> of September, 2019 and found that the claim of the candidate is devoid of merit and hence liable for rejection; and

Now, therefore, having accorded consideration to the claim of the petitioner namely **Sham Lal S/o Shonku Ram R/o Village Sitti, Post Office Sitt, Tehsil Bani, District Kathua** in due deference to the order dated 26.03.2018 passed by the Hon'ble High Court in SWP No. 280/2018 titled Sham Lal V/s State of J&K and others,the case of the candidate being devoid of merit, is rejected.
