Subject: O.A No. 61/1089/2020 titled Ashuni Khajuria V/s UT of J&K and others.

Whereas, the Jammu and Kashmir Services Selection Board advertised the post of Accounts Assistant (Panchayat) in the Department of Rural Development & Panchayati Raj under the provisions of S.O- 127 of 2020 dated 20.04.2020, under Various District Cadres in pursuant to Advertisement Notification No. 02 of 2020 dated 06.07.2020 and the criteria adopted by the Board is as per S.O-180 dated 28.05.2020 and the selection for aforesaid posts shall be made on the basis of written test only; and

Whereas, the Jammu and Kashmir Services Selection Board conducted the written test for the aforesaid post on 10th November, 2020; and

Whereas, the applicant namely Ashuni Khajuria filed O.A before the Hon'ble Central Administrative Tribunal, Jammu bearing O.A No. 61/1089/2020 titled Ashuni Khajuria Vs UT of J&K and Others seeking following reliefs:-

Directing the Respondents to conduct a special exam of the applicant and consider the case of the applicant for appointment on the basis of the merit obtained by the applicant.

Pass any such order or orders which this Hon'ble Tribunal may deem fit.

Whereas, the Hon'ble Tribunal vide its order dated 26th November, 2020 disposed of the O.A with the following directions:-

“OA is accordingly disposed of at admission stage by directing the respondents to consider and dispose of the pending complaint of the applicant dated 14.11.2020, annexure A/5, by passing a reasoned and speaking order within a period of one month from the date of receipt of copy of this order..”

Whereas, the J&K Services Selection Board has already conducted the examination of Accounts Assistant (Panchayats) and also declared the result and issued provisional Selection List. Whereas, the applicant in this case was himself at fault by not showing the relevant identity proof before the appropriate authority which like thousands of other candidates would have enabled to participate in the examination process; and

Whereas, the instructions with regard to examination were repeatedly notified and the same were reflected on the Admit cards of every individual candidate. Since 1.62 lakh candidates appeared in the aforesaid examination and it would not be possible for the Board to conduct a special examination as such there is no merit in the representation of the applicant; and

Whereas, the J&K Services Selection Board sought report from the Centre Superintendent, GHS Bun Doda and he submitted that the exact opening time of main gate for candidates was 11.00 AM, where the scrutiny of documents for identification at threshold was arranged, so that non-genuine person is not allowed to enter the examination center and the applicant appeared without any genuine Identity Proof and was advised to bring some genuine Identity which would clear the doubt regarding his identity and the candidate never approached back with genuine Identity and the applicant also never approached any Observer, Magistrate regarding his grievances and the grievance redressal mechanism was set up by the JKSSB observer appointed by the Board and there was a Observer available in the Examination Centre too, so the whole of the issue is blown by the candidate in figment of imagination as at the time


of Examination, he was not found with genuine ID proof which lead him not to be allowed to sit in examination and further the allegation against In-charge female officer too don't hold good in favour of the applicant who himself as well as that lady official don't know each other, and then why she would plan to oust him when she has no benefit out of that and planned conspiracy as mentioned in representation/complaint too is un explained in the circumstances as per guidelines entry was not allowed after 11.45AM, so nobody could be allowed to sit in after lapse of above said time; and

Whereas the report of the Centre observer has also been scrutinized and it has been found that no irregularity/mal-practice was noticed during examination in the Centre and the examination was conducted smoothly; and

Whereas, the matter was examined by the J&K Services Selection Board in its 182nd meeting held on 23rd April, 2021 in compliance to the directions of the Hon'ble Central Administrative Tribunal, Jammu and the report of the Centre Superintendent, GHS Bun Doda, it was found that there is no merit in the representation of the applicant. Accordingly, it was decided by the Board that speaking order rejecting the claim of the candidate shall be issued.

Now, therefore, in deference to order dated 26.09.2020 passed by the Hon'ble Tribunal in O.A No. 61/1089/2020 titled Ashuni Khajuria Vs UT of J&K and Others and as per the decision of the Board, the claim of the applicant namely **Ashuni Khajuria S/o Sh. Dhani Raj R/o Jagota, Tehsil Thatri, District Doda** is considered for the post of Accounts Assistant (Panchayat), Department of Rural Development & Panchayati Raj, pursuant to Advertisement Notification No. 02 of 2020 dated 06.07.2020 and found devoid of any merit; hence is rejected.
