**Subject: O.A bearing No 061/824/2020 titled Puran Chand Choudhary Vs UT of J&K and others.**

Whereas, the J&K Services Selection Board advertised various posts including the posts of Store Keeper-cum-Clerk cum Computer Operator in the Health and Medical Education Department (GMC Rajouri), Divisional Cadre Jammu vide Advertisement Notification No. 03 of 2019 dated 01.02.2019 under Item No. 33; and

Whereas, the J&K Services Selection Board after completion of the selection process, issued the Selection List and forwarded the same to the Indenting/Administrative Department vide communication No. SSB/Secy/Sel/ 52/J/2019/5436-42 dated 18.10.2019 whereby two candidates were selected under Ex Servicemen Category (having regard to 6% horizontal reservation to the ESM), the candidate namely Maroof Hussain S/o Bashir Ahmed secured 30.50 points and figured at serial no.28 under OM/ESM Category and Suresh Kumar S/o Dev Raj OM/ESM secured 21.50 points and figured at serial no. 29 under OM/ESM Category for the aforesaid post;and

Whereas, the applicant Puran Chand Choudhary(ESM) S/o Dev Raj secured only 20.25 points and could not make grade for selection and hence was not selected for the aforesaid post; and

Whereas, the applicant approached the Hon'ble Central Administrative Tribunal through the medium of OA No. 824/2020 praying therein for directing the respondents to recommend and appoint the applicant as Store Keeper-Cum-Clerk cum Computer Operator in GMC, Rajouri against the vacant post under Ex-Servicemen category which has fallen vacant due to non-joining and double selection of Maroof Hussain s/o Bashir Ahmed R/o Doda;and

Whereas, the Hon'ble Tribunal vide order dated 21.09.2020 disposed of the application with the following directions:-

**"In view of the above submissions made by the applicants counsel, we direct the respondents/competent authority to consider the candidature of the applicant, Sh. Puran Chand for the post of Store Keeper-cum-Clerk which has fallen vacant under Ex-serviceman cadre due to non-joining and double selection of one Mr. Maroof Hussain and decide the representation of the applicant dated 14.02.2020 by passing a reasoned and speaking order within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. It is made clear that we have not entered into the merit of the case.**


**In view of the above, the OA is disposed of. No Costs";and**

Whereas, in compliance to the directions of the Hon'ble Tribunal, Jammu, the matter was examined by the J&K Services Selection Board in its 178<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 10<sup>th</sup> January, 2021 and it was found that the Selection List was prepared by the Board in accordance with the rules in vogue. Rule 14(7) of J&K Civil Services (Decentralization and Recruitment) Rules,2010 provides that the concerned Selection committees of the Board shall also draw up a waiting list and forward the same, through Board, to the requisitioning authority for consideration against drop out vacancies. The waiting list shall remain in force for a period of one year from the date the original Select List is sent to the requisitioning authority. The Selection Committee shall not maintain or recommend any Select or Waiting list for any future vacancy or any vacancy caused on account of resignation by any selectee after appointment. As such, the Board after forwarding

the Selection List along with the wait list to the Indenting Department becomes Officio functus. Also there is no provision for forwarding the second Wait List against drop out vacancies. Besides, the General Administration Department has also clarified the same and the Hon'ble J&K High Court has also in a number of judgments upheld the said position and accordingly, it was resolved to reject the claim of the applicant by passing a speaking order.

Now, therefore, in deference to Judgment/order dated 21.09.2020 passed by the Hon'ble High Court in O.A bearing No 061/824/2020 titled Puran Chand Choudhary Vs UT of J&K and others, the claim of the applicant namely **Puran Chand Choudhary S/o Dev Raj, R/O Dhanaka, Chowki Tehsil Nowshera, Rajouri**, for the post of Store Keeper-cum-Clerk cum Computer Operator in the Health and Medical Education Department (GMC Rajouri), Divisional Cadre Jammu pursuance to Advertisement Notification No. 03 of 2019/33 dated 01.02.2019 has been examined in the 178<sup>th</sup> Board meeting with reference to the rules/record on the subject and found to be devoid of any merit and accordingly rejected.
