Subject:- SWP No. 1497/2016 titled Palvi Sharma V/s State of J&K and others.

Whereas, the Jammu and Kashmir Services Selection Board advertised various posts including the post of Assistant Tailor Master (Industries and Commerce Department) , Division Cadre Jammu in pursuant to Advertisement Notification No. 03 of 2012 dated 28.12.2012 under Item No. 191; and

Whereas, the Jammu and Kashmir Services Selection Board after completion of the selection process, issued the Selection List and forwarded the same to the Indenting Department (Industries and Commerce Department) vide communication No. SSB/Secy/Sel/2017/2266-72 dated 22.02.2017; and

Whereas, feeling aggrieved the petitioner namely Palvi Sharma filed writ petition bearing SWP No. 1497/2016 titled Palvi Sharma V/s State of J&K and others, seeking following reliefs:-

- a. **“Commanding the Respondents to conduct the interview of the petitioner for the post Assistant Tailor Master Division Cadre Jammu under Handicapped category pursuant to advertisement notice no. 03 of 2012 dated 28.12.2012.**
- b. **Commanding the Respondents to consider the petitioner for selection and appointment to the post of assistant tailor Master Division Cadre Jammu under Handicapped category pursuant to advertisement notice no. 03 of 2012 dated 28.12.2012.”**

Whereas, the Hon’ble High Court, Jammu vide its Order dated 23.07.2016 passed the following directions: **“the Respondent shall conduct the interview of the petitioner, though at her own risk, in case she figures in the shortlist. Appearing in the interview shall not vest right of selection on the petitioner, until and without orders by this Court”**; and

Whereas, the Jammu and Kashmir Services Selection Board vide notice endorsement No. SSB/Secy/Sel/2017/1363-71 dated 30.01.2017 conducted the interview of the petitioner Palvi Sharma on the directions of the Hon’ble High Court in SWP NO. 1497/2016; and the Hon’ble High Court vide order dated 02.03.2020 disposed of the writ petition with the following directions: -


“while considering this matter, the Court in terms of order passed on 23.07.2016 directed the Respondents to conduct the interview of the petitioner on her risk and responsibility and on her making a grade in the shortlist and appearance in the interview shall not form ground for claiming the merit without claim in selection”; and

The relief prayed for by the petitioner has been granted, therefore, let the petitioner approach the Services Selection Board for having the information regarding the position made in the merit list within two weeks and the Services Selection Board shall supply the information to the petitioner on her approach within two weeks. Thereafter, the petitioner shall work out his remedy .Disposed of as above”; and

Whereas, the petitioner namely Palvi Sharma secured 39.9333 points under OM category and the last selected candidate under OM category secured 48.2667 points and the waiting/OM cutoff is 47.8667 points.

Now, therefore, in due deference to the order/Judgment dated 02.03.2020 passed by the Hon’ble High Court in SWP No 1497/2016 titled Palvi Sharma V/s State of J&K and others, I am directed to inform you that as per the records available, you have secured 39.9333 points which are much less than the last candidate selected under Open merit for the post of Assistant Tailor Master (Industries and Commerce Department) , Divisional Cadre Jammu in pursuance of the Advertisement Notification No. 03 of 2012 dated 28.12.2012 under Item No. 191, due to which you could not make grade to the Selection List. The Merit position is also enclosed herewith for you information.
