**ORDER NO. 335 -SSB of 2021**  
**DATED: 28 -09-2021**

Subject: - CCPS No. 411/2019 titled Syed Umra Ahsan V/S Rahul Sharma, Chairman JKSSB in SWP NO. 2180/2018 titled Syed Umra Ahsan V/s State of J&K & Ors.

**WHEREAS,** the J&K Services Selection Board advertised various posts including 05 posts of Vocational Instructor Mechanic Consumer Electronics, in Technical Education Department, Divisional Cadre Jammu, vide an Advertisement Notice No. 01 of 2011 dated 31.01.2011 under Item No. 128 with the following breakup:- OM=03,ST=01 & RBA=01, and

Whereas, the qualification prescribed for the aforesaid post is as under:-  
"Diploma in Electronics & Telecommunication with three years' experience in the relevant field or Graduation in any stream + higher National Trade Certificate (HNTC) in Consumer Electronics from ATI-EPI with three years' experience in the relevant field" and

Whereas, **the criteria adopted by the Board is as under:-**

- (i) Marks obtained in the written test out of Maximum marks to be proportionately converted into points =80 points and  
(ii) Viva voce =20 points.

Whereas the petitioner was called for the interview under RBA category but at the time of interview she was not able to produce valid and renewed category certificate, thus she was considered and interviewed under OM category with the remarks as not eligible on the ground that she has not produced a valid experience certificate of three years, and

Whereas, the selection list for the aforesaid post was forwarded to the indenting department with the remarks as " post unfilled for want of certain clarification" at serial No. 03 under OM category of Selection list, and

Whereas, the petitioner feeling aggrieved of being declared as not eligible in the interview approached the Hon'ble High Court by filing SWP No. 2180/2018 titled Syed Umra Ahsan Vs State and others and the Hon'ble Court was pleased to dispose of the petition vide Judgement dated 26.10.2018. the operative part whereof is reproduced as:


"Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 17.01.2018 and decide the same in accordance with rules governing the field, provided there is no legal impediment in doing so, within a period of eight weeks from the date, certified copy of this order alongwith copy of the writ petition is provided to the respondents. Decision in this regard may be communicated to the petitioner by passing a speaking order. IA also stands disposed of as such."

Whereas, in compliance with the Judgement of the Hon'ble High Court the case of the petitioner was examined and placed in 183<sup>rd</sup> Board meeting held on 24.6.2021 for consideration wherein it was observed that the RBA Certificate has been issued in favour of the candidate after the Cut-off date and moreover the candidate possessed experience of only

2 years instead 3 years as on Cut-Off date. The Board accordingly, decided to declare the candidate as Not Eligible and reject his case as being devoid of the merits.

Now, therefore, in deference to Judgment, dated 26.10.2018 passed by the Hon'ble High Court in SWP NO. 2180/2018 and IA No 01/2018 titled Syed Umra Ahsan VS State of J&K and others and as per the decision of the Board, the claim of the petitioner namely Syed Umra Ahsan D/o Syed Mohammad Ahsan R/o Village Dodaj, Tehsil Darhal District Rajouri has been considered and found to be devoid of merit and hence rejected.
