Subject: Selection List of the candidates for the post of Motor Vehicle Traffic Assistant, Item No. 87, 91 and 95 of Transport Department, UT Cadre, Divisional Cadre, Kashmir/Jammu under Notification No. 04 of 2020 dated 16.12.2020- Cancellation of Selection thereof.

Whereas, the J&K Services Selection Board notified the Selection List of the candidates for the post of Motor Vehicle Traffic Assistant, Item No. 87, 91 and 95 of Transport Department, UT & Divisional Cadre Kashmir/Jammu, advertised vide Notification No. 04 of 2020 dated 16.12.2020 and forwarded the same to the Indenting Department vide letter No. SSB/Sel/Secy/2022/5950-54 dated 06.09.2022 for further course of action; and

Whereas, among others, the recommendation of Mr. Syed Zamir Ahmad, S/o Syed Ahmad Shah Bedar figuring at Sr. No. 01/RBA in the Selection List for the post of Motor Vehicle Assistant, UT Cadre, under item No. 087 was kept withheld subject to equivalence/relevance of qualification with the prescribed one; and

Whereas, the JKSSB vide letter No. JKSSB-SD0SECY (KAS)38/2022 dated 07.10.2022 followed by reminders dated 20.02.2023 & 24.08.2023 took up the matter with Higher Education Department to clarify whether the "One year Broad Based Basic Training Course (BBBT) in Automobile Sector & Six months Advanced Module of Auto Electrical Electronics & Air Conditioning in Automobile Sector (AAT03) and Six months Specialized (On the Job training) totaling 2 years" can be considered for the post of Motor Vehicle Traffic Assistant or otherwise; and

Whereas, the Higher Education Department, vide letter No. HED-GAZ/365/2022-04 dated 13.07.2023 clarified as under:

"The Broad Based Basic Training scheme in the COE was started in the year 2007 with an objective to provide skill workforce to industries. The candidates on successful completion of their training were awarded in National Trade Certificate under the CoE scheme. The CoE scheme has since been discontinued from August 2015. In addition, the trades being offered under the CTS have also been made NSQF compliant. Therefore, the erstwhile 2 year CoE trade (which were formed by a combination of one year BBBT plus

6 months advance module and another 6 months of specialized module) is no longer equivalent with Mechanic Motor Vehicle trade under the CTS. In 2019, The DGT had revised the "Private" candidate guidelines for certification in which the private candidate can appear for the CTS scheme. Under these guidelines, the erstwhile CoE based candidates can also obtain the NTC in the mapped trades. Therefore, as per the existing provision, CoE candidates can register as private candidates and appear in the AITT examination in the mapped trades".

Whereas, the case of the said candidate was again placed in the 260th Board Meeting held on 15.02.2024, which decided as under;

"The Board deliberated the matter and observed that there is an ambiguity in the clarification furnished by Higher Education Department and the concerned Selection Division would need to re-examine it, more specifically with reference to the date of completion of the Degree by the candidate."

Whereas, the matter was again taken up with the Higher Education Department vide letter dated 27.06.2024, to clearly indicate whether the candidate can be considered as eligible for the post as per the educational qualification possessed by him; and

Whereas, the Higher Education Department, vide letter No. HED-GAZ/365/2022- 04 dated 27.06.2024, has conveyed as under:

The "One year Broad Based Basic Training (BBBT) in Automobile sector and six months Advanced Module of Auto Electrical Electronics and Air Conditioning in Automobile Sector (AATO3) and six months specialized (on the job training) totaling 2 years at ITI Srinagar" is not equivalent to "10th with ITI Motor Mechanic Vehicle of two years course from any recognized institute" as per the clarification provided by Directorate General of Training (DGT), Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship, Government of India, New Delhi vide No. MSDE(DGT)-07/11/2022-CD(E-55244) dated 25.05.2023."

Whereas, the withheld recommendation case of Mr. Syed Zamir Ahmad, selected for the post of Motor Vehicle Assistant, UT Cadre, under item No. 087, figuring at Sr. No. 01/RBA was again placed in 284th Board meeting for discussion and deliberation and the Board took the decision reproduced as under:

"The Board deliberated the case and taking note of the clarification from the Higher Education Department, vide letter No. HED-GAZ/365/2022-04 dated 27.06.2024, decided to cancel the withheld recommendation of the candidate namely Mr. Syed Zamir Ahmad S/o Syed Ahmad Shah Bedar under RBA Category for the posts of Motor Vehicle Assistant, UT Cadre/Item No. 087 of the Transport Department, advertised vide Notification No. 04 of 2020 dated 16.12.2020, UT Cadre, Divisional Cadre, Kashmir/Jammu, on account of failing to meet the requisite qualification."

Now therefore, in view of the above stated facts and decision of the Board, the withheld recommendation of Mr. Syed Zamir Ahmad, S/o Syed Ahmad Shah Bedar figuring at Sr. No. 01/RBA in the Selection List for the post of Motor Vehicle Assistant, Transport Department, UT Cadre, pursuant to Advertisement Notification No. 04 of 2020 dated 16.12.2020, under item No. 087 is hereby **cancelled**. The Indenting Department may operate the waiting list, if required, in accordance with extant rules.
