ORDER NO. 364 -SSB of 2021

Subject: - OA No. 61/451/2021 titled Lakhvinder Singh V/s UT of J&K and Others

Whereas, that the J&K Services Selection Board (JKSSB) advertised posts of Driver, Divisional Cadre, Jammu Health and Medical Education Department (GMC Rajouri) vide Adv. Notice No.03 of 2019 dated 01.02.2019, Item no. 40 with the following breakup: -

OM=06, RBA=03, SC=01, ST=01, ALC=01 Total=12 and

Whereas, the prescribed qualification for the aforesaid post is as under:-
“Minimum Matric and Maximum 10+2 with valid HMV License;” and

Whereas, after completion of the selection process, the Selection List was issued and forwarded to the Indenting department vide communication no. SSB/Secy/Sel/J/79/2020/3079-85 dated 08.05.2020 wherein the applicant namely Lakhvinder Singh figured in the selection list at serial no. 02/OM Category, but his recommendation was kept withheld for want of clarification regarding requisite qualification, and


Whereas, the applicant feeling aggrieved of his withheld recommendation approached the Hon'ble Central Administrative Tribunal, Jammu by filling O.A. No. 451/2021 titled Lakhvinder Singh V/s UT of J&K and Others and the Hon'ble Tribunal vide its order dated 15.03.2021 disposed of the said O.A with the following directions:-**“Looking to the limited prayer made by the counsel for the applicant, we dispose of the OA with direction to the respondents to consider and dispose of the representation dated 17.11.2020 preferred by the applicant by passing a reasoned and speaking order and communicate the decision so taken to the applicant within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. It is made clear that we have not entered into the merits of the case. There shall be no orders as to cost.”and**

Whereas, in pursuance of the aforesaid directions of the Hon'ble Central Administrative Tribunal (CAT), the case was examined by the Sub-Committee and recommended to declare the candidate as Not Eligible, for having higher than the prescribed qualification as mentioned in application form, subject to approval of Board, and

Whereas, subsequently, the matter was placed before the J&K Services Selection Board in its 186th Board meeting held on 26.08.2021 and 27.08.2021 in compliance with the directions of the Hon'ble Tribunal, Jammu and as per recruitment rules in vogue, and it was decided to reject the claim of the petitioner by way of issuing a speaking order in this regard; and

Now, therefore, in deference to the order dated 15.03.2021 passed by the Hon'ble Central Administrative Tribunal, Jammu in OA No. 61/451/2021 titled Lakhvinder Singh v/s UT of J&K & Others, and as per the decision of the Board, the Candidature of the petitioner namely Lakhvinder Singh has been considered for the Post of Driver, (GMC Rajouri) Divisional Cadre, Jammu in pursuance to Advertisement Notification No. 03 of 2019 dated 01.02.2019 under Item No. 40, and rejected, being without any merit.
